

Foreword

Dear Teacher / Parent

The book contains sets of worksheets aimed at imparting knowledge to the child related to language, art, mathematics, drawing and general knowledge.

The worksheets are designed using the concept of collaborative learning so that the child can develop a holistic learning pattern in the foundation years of her/his education. These worksheets will help achieving various yardsticks and levels of learning:

Knowledge - Can students recall facts?

Comprehension - Can students understand and explain ideas?

Application - Can students use ideas?

Analysis - Do students see relationships (contrasts, comparisons, breaking into parts)

Synthesis - Can students combine the parts to make whole?

Evaluation - Can students make judgments?

By using these categories, we have designed more effective and comprehensive curriculum and evaluative instruments for children at various levels of cognitive growth.

There are instructions given on every worksheet. The learning of the child will depend upon the ability of the parent / teacher as how sincerely they follow the instructions and emphasise on the objectives.

There are teacher / parent guiding notes before each set of worksheets pertaining to a subject. Parents / Teachers must read the guiding notes and instructions carefully to understand and implement them. These worksheets are for the child so make sure that you may help and guide if required but don't do them for the child.

The worksheets are perforated. The child should be given one worksheet at a time and once completed you may keep them in separate folder.

"My Planner" is a designed keeping in mind the most logical flow of the curriculum for the child to learn. Parents / Teachers may decide to change as per their requirements. Keep a track of worksheets by maintaining the record.

There are three sets of Self Assessment given at the end of the worksheets. It is important to note that the scores in these assessments are not important, what is important is the learning and understanding ability of the child.

Guiding notes for Parent / Teacher

Fostering creativity in Kids is an integral part of early child development programme. You are helping the child to develop mental, social and emotional skills. Creating art may boost young children's ability to analyze and problem-solve in different ways. As kids manipulate a paintbrush or use wax colours or pencil colours, their fine motor skills improve. Kids love doing a variety of arts and crafts as an outlet to be creative and have some fun.

Physiologically, the human brain consists of 2 parts, the left and the right hemisphere. The left brain is used in logical thinking and analytical processes. This is typically what is trained in school work that consists of math, reading and science. The right brain is used in emotional perception, intuition and creativity. It is the right brain that is mainly used when a person is involved in creative endeavours such as making art. It is this part of the brain that is developed by engaging children in creative work like drawing, painting, music, dance, craft, etc.

It appears that for the brain to be efficient, the two hemispheres of the brains must work together. By stimulating and exercising the right hemisphere of the brain, the arts strengthen the connection between the hemispheres. Kids should be exposed to arts so that their cognitive skills mature. This will enable their right brain to develop equally as the left, and both hemispheres to work in tandem, thus achieving the full potential of the mind.

There are some key benefits of Arts and Crafts:

Bilateral Coordination – Crafts such as colouring, drawing, cutting all require your child to use both of their hands together.

Fine Motor Coordination – In order to draw shapes, cut patterns, and write, your child is required to use their fine motor coordination.

Self Regulation – Crafts that require drying require waiting! This is a great lesson for your child to demonstrate self control and patience.

Self-esteem Booster – Although we want to challenge our kids, it is also important to initially choose arts and crafts that are at your child's skill level. Completing the crafts successfully will give them a great sense of accomplishment and pride

Bonding and Fun – Your kids will love spending time with you and creating something together!

Parents / Teachers may help the child in initial stage of learning but should never make the child dependent on them. Read the instructions given on each worksheet carefully and try to follow.

The following important points must be remembered by Parents / Teachers to make the drawing, arts & craft a part of your kid's development:

- Always make arts and crafts supply available and accessible to your kid – paper, pencil, crayons, etc.
- Celebrate your child's artwork – hang their drawings on the wall or save it in a folder. That way, your child feels that her / his creation is important.
- Enjoy the arts at home – share your artistic skills and interests with your kid. Find out what your kid loves about the art.
